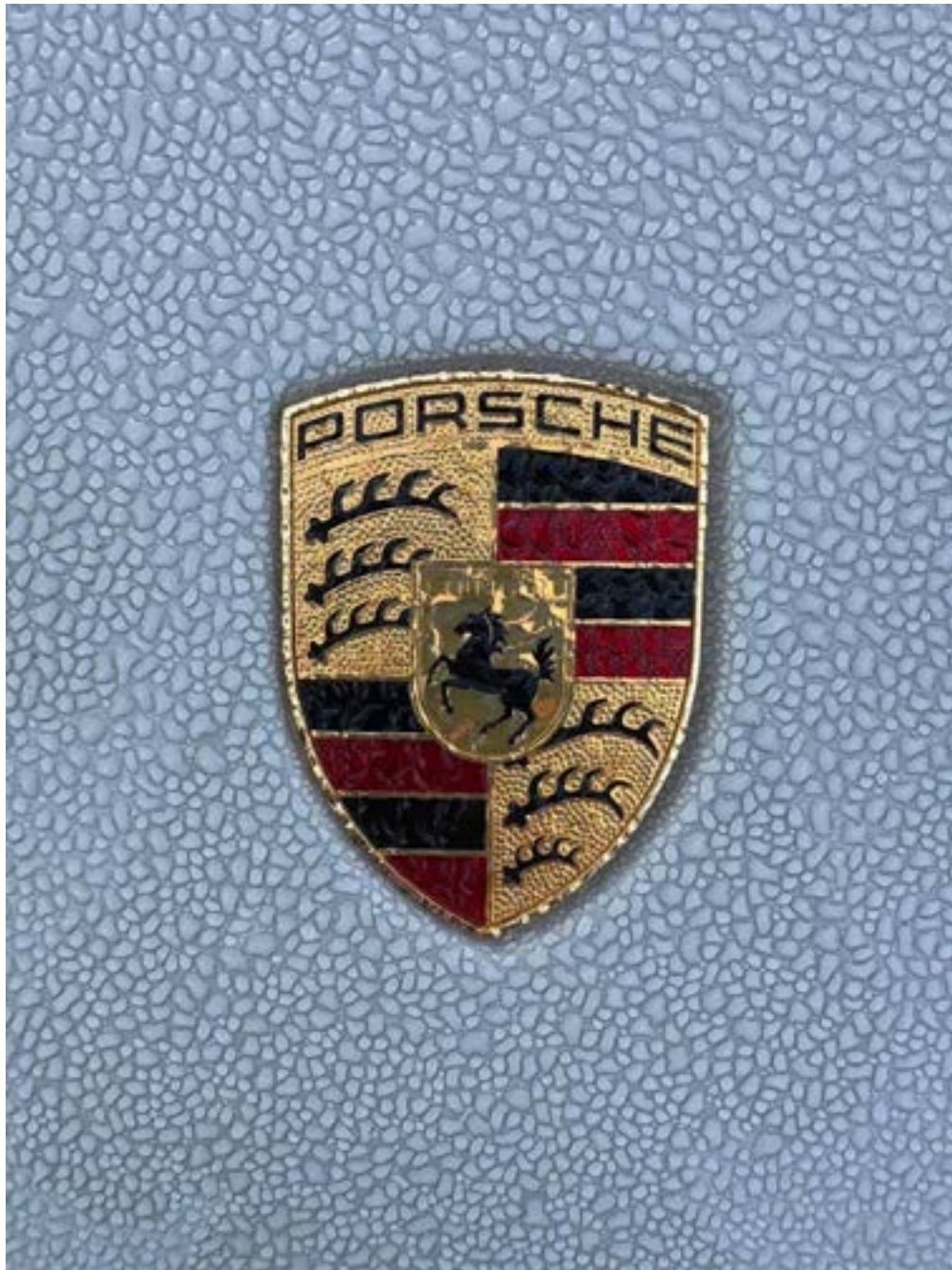

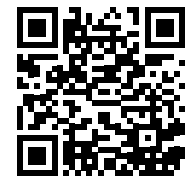

My 3rd 914 is #11 of 500 of the 914 LE Can Am "Creamsicle" - the rarest 914 production car built. I've named it "Valentine" because its production date is 14 February 1974. In it's day, it typically took a few days for a car to leave the factory after it was built for car prep, staging the cars for shipping, and then being loaded onto trucks or rail to be shipped to their destinations. So it is very likely that my car left the factory on the day I was born - 17 February 1974.

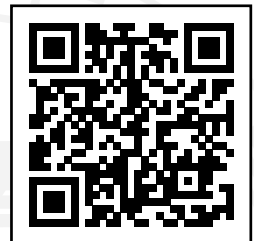
