Florida Crown Region activity has been off the scale of being busy! This two-month issue will be full of information, but I looked ahead to the summer months, and we have a few things scheduled but this is where you, as a member, can help the region.

The FCR Board cannot possibly know of every activity in this large region. We have recently planned to schedule some tech sessions with area repair shops and Porsche Jacksonville. Expect more of these types of tech sessions. What would you like to learn? What's inside your transmission? Clutch replacement? Is a lightened flywheel a good idea? What suspension is better for track and autocrosses?

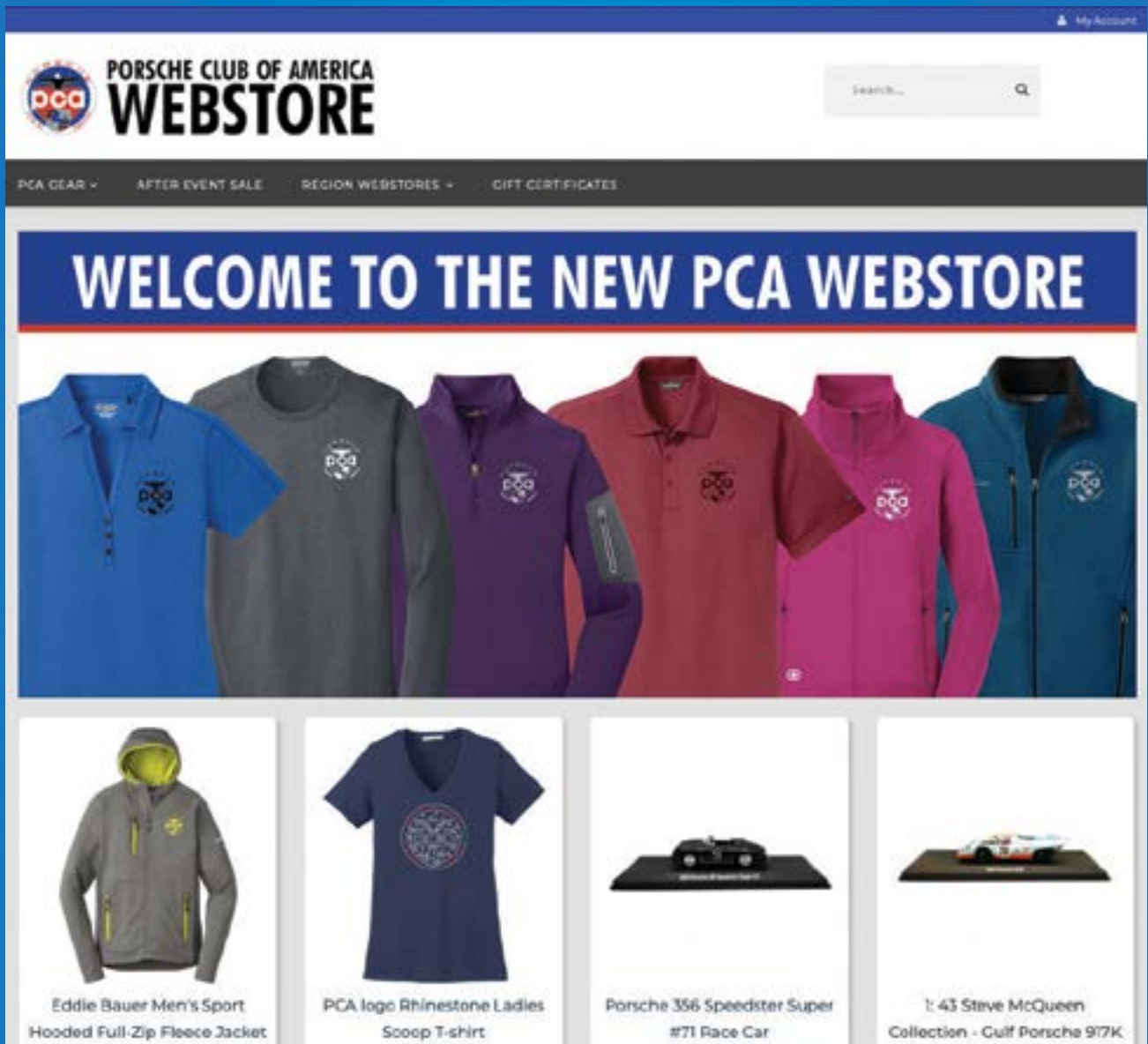
Any newer automobile is much more complex than the early 911, 914, or 944 that I owned. The only chip for early 911 was a wood chip from your wood pile. No one is taking off their fuel injection to put Weber carbs on their new GT-3. We, as Porsche owners, are limited in the DIY to brake pads, tires, oil, gas, and suspension changes. That is assuming we are not building a race car.

There's huge range of tires and rims to choose from. I have two sets of rims in addition to the wheels and tires on my 996. The genius I bought my 996 from was running 19" rims and doing DEs at Watkins Glen. He included a set of 17-inch rims in the sale but no 18's. I now have 200 tread wear tires on the extra set of 18's.

I have a set of softer brake pads for DEs in the garage. That is one thing that an owner can possibly do themselves. Putting on your extra set of rims at the track or in your garage is another DIY. What's the offset of your rims? Why does it matter? Can I put in a bigger rollbar of my Porsche to help with handling? Does my Porsche even have a rollbar? What will interfere with the active suspension in a Porsche? Is it faster to left foot brake at a track event?

Some of you will be concerned with the type of wax or clear coat for your exterior. The best way to take care of the leather seats. FCR is running events to answer all those questions. We want to hear from you! Have an idea for a tech session, DIY, or a project then let us know!
